

Below you will find care instructions for the various types of jewelry Perfect Memorials offers. Although there are specific instructions for each type, there are several universal recommendations that should be followed.



Please do not shower, bathe, or swim in your new cremation jewelry



Please avoid strenuous activity (like exercise and gardening) while wearing the jewelry



Please do not sleep wearing the jewelry

To preserve the life of your cremation jewelry follow these basic recommendations. Periodically, your cremation jewelry may need to be cleaned. Please refer to the section below to see cleaning instructions that are specific to the type of jewelry you have chosen. How to care for:



Stainless Steel

Mix warm water with a small amount of mild dish soap. Use a sponge or soft cloth to wipe the jewelry down with the soap and water. Dry thoroughly with a soft cloth. **DO NOT** submerge or soak the jewelry in water or any other chemical.



Sterling Silver

Use a rouge cloth to lightly rub any visible tarnish off of your jewelry. If significant tarnish develops please use a silver cleaning cream to buff the tarnish away. **DO NOT** submerge or soak the jewelry in water or any other chemical. If storing for long periods place inside a silver keeper bag.



Gold Vermeil

Rub very gently with a soft 100% cotton or microfiber cloth. Buffing will remove gold finish. **NEVER** use chemical cleaners on gold vermeil jewelry, as it can strip the gold finish. It is natural for gold vermeil jewelry to tarnish slightly with time. **DO NOT** submerge or soak the jewelry in water or any other chemical.



Solid Gold

Mix warm water with a small amount of mild dish soap. Use a sponge or soft cloth to wipe the jewelry down with the soap and water. Dry thoroughly with a soft cloth. Use a rouge cloth to lightly buff away small scratches and fingerprints. **DO NOT** submerge or soak the jewelry in water or any other chemical.



Wood

Mix warm water with a small amount of mild dish soap. Use a sponge or soft cloth to wipe the jewelry down with the soap and water mixture. Dry thoroughly with a soft cloth. **DO NOT** submerge or soak the jewelry in water or any other chemical.



Photo Pendants

Do not buff or polish photo pendants. There is no need to use a cleaner or even soap to maintain these pendants. The engraving is very light and could be removed, even by hand buffing. Please only use a very soft cloth to wipe away smudges and fingerprints. **DO NOT** submerge or soak the jewelry in water or any other chemical.
